Reviewing these two examples of program logic models may provide ideas and insights about how to develop your own logic model.

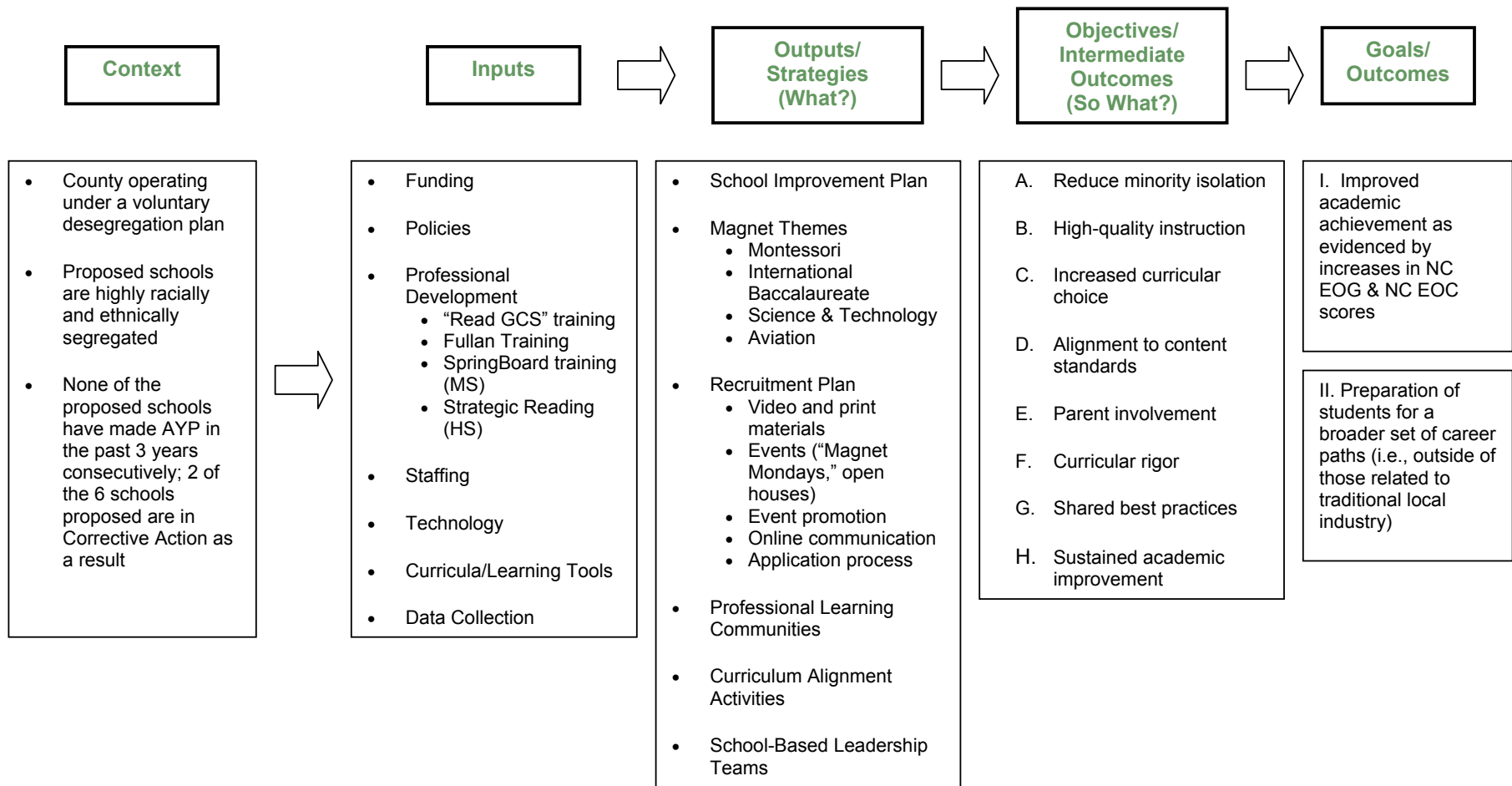
